Risotto Recipe

- Combine some butter and olive oil in a pan
- Add 12 ounces of Arborio rice, some salt, and the zest of a lemon; sauté until the rice turns golden.
 - Start adding small cupfuls of hot chicken stock, stirring until each addition is absorbed before adding the next. Continue until whole carton has been absorbed.
 - Then stir in the zest of another lemon, a couple of fistfuls of Parmigiano-Reggiano, and half a carton of crème fraîche. Serve with veal chops.
