ORDER ON MOTION TO REVOKE PRO  
HAC VICE

(Dkt. Nos. 15, 49)

11 On May 23, 2018, the Court issued a tentative ruling  
12 granting Berkeley's motion to revoke pro hac vice admission of  
13 Larry Klayman. Docket No. 49. The parties then submitted  
14 supplemental briefing and appeared for a hearing. Docket Nos.  
15 66, 71, 72, 73. Klayman presents no new arguments or facts that  
16 would change the Court's tentative ruling. The Court addresses  
17 some of Klayman's points. Judge Gould's dissenting opinion in In  
18 re Bundy, 840 F.3d 1034 (9th Cir. 2016), was already before the  
19 Court at the time of the tentative ruling. The Court  
20 nevertheless found the reasoning of the majority opinion to be  
21 more persuasive. Moreover, even though the D.C. Bar's  
22 recommendation is still on appeal, its findings that Klayman  
23 violated Rules of Professional Responsibility were still  
24 instructive. Accordingly, the Court hereby makes its tentative  
25 ruling final and GRANTS Berkeley's motion. Robles' remaining  
26 counsel, Michael Kolodzi, shall continue to represent her.


